Dear Parents,

A warm welcome back to everyone to Ysgol y Llys after the summer holidays. We hope everyone has enjoyed a good summer, although the weather in August wasn't brilliant- we are sure to enjoy an Indian summer in September as schools re-open! Here is an update on school arrangements for the forthcoming term.

SCHOOL MEALS- The price for a school meal this term is £2.50 per head. At this present time, the cost of school meals will only apply to pupils in Years 5 and 6. This is due to the Free School Meal initiative which is currently being rolled out by the Welsh Assembly Government. From September 2023 in Denbighshire this will be extended to pupils in Reception, Years 1,2,3,4. We expect that this will be rolled out further to include Years 5 and 6 later in this academic year.

*Note- Those pupils entitled to Free School Meal and who do not wish to take up the offer are still allowed to bring their own packed lunch to school. However, we would encourage eligible families to take up the free school meal offer, especially in times of credit crunch and increased living costs. We will share the school menu for the term via email to parents before the end of the week.

Punctuality- Remember! The school bell rings at 8.55am in the morning and it is expected that pupils are already on site on the school yard. Pupils may arrive on site by 8.40am onwards. If pupils arrive late, they are expected to sign into school in reception. This will help us to track attendance and punctuality and support parents and families who might require additional support.

School opening / closing times: Please remember that school finished for Foundation Phase pupils at 3.00pm and finished for Juniors (Years 3,4,5,6) at 3.15pm. Please note- NO VEHICLES are permitted on site / along school drive during these peak times.

Lost Property- Please ensure your child's name is on all items of clothing. This will help identify items of clothing and ensure our lost property items are kept to a minimum.

Administration of Medicine- From time to time, your child may require medicine to be administered whilst in school. Please ensure that the relevant medical form is updated and completed and returned to school. Copies are available upon request from school reception.

After school Clubs and Activities- The timetable of after school activities will be shared with parents via email later this week.

Health and Safety- You will have seen coverage in national press of schools in England being affected by the RAAC concrete and being having to be closed with urgent remedial works carried out. Please see response from DDC:

"Denbighshire County Council would like to reassure elected members, governors, parents and school staff that it has taken all reasonable steps to ascertain the structural integrity of its buildings and has no evidence to suggest any of its buildings are at risk. The Council will work with Welsh Government to instigate surveys of all school buildings if required."

Communication with Parents- As you are aware, we communicate with parents in a number of different ways. Weekly newsletters are sent via email, you may follow our official Twitter account @YYllys, our official Facebook account or via our school website, <https://ysgollllys.co.uk/>. We will be sharing updates on exciting Schoolcomms app which we are looking to introduce during this term- watch this space!

SEESAW- We have been using the Seesaw platform in order to share pupils progress, photos of activities with parents. It has also previously been a medium for parents to communicate directly with class teachers. This will change slightly from September- SEESAW will continue to be used to share photographs, updates on activities and to share class messages. However, to communicate directly with class teachers, parents will need to communicate via staff professional HWB school email accounts. These contact details will be shared via Seesaw within Units later during the week.



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We will also update parents on information regarding which information should be requested from teaching staff and which enquiries should be made to general school email address ysgol.yllys@denbighshire.gov.uk. We will also clarify when emails should be submitted and expected timescales for replies.

Admission to Ysgol y Llys- The online forms for admission to various age groups for the 2024-25 academic years will be opening soon. Parents are advised to complete within the scheduled timeframe to ensure requests are submitted to Denbighshire Authority on time. Please follow this link for further information
