Weather Forecast-Ysgol y Llys procedures in contacting parents / Inclement Weather Procedure

In case the weather deteriorates over the next few weeks, bringing snow and ice, I write to inform you about how we contact parents regarding closing school during extreme weather/unusual circumstances. The decision to close a school is never made lightly. Every effort will be made to keep the school open but several factors must be taken into consideration – children and staff's health and safety and the number of staff who are absent due to bad weather.

In the past we have closed the whole of the school because of bad weather and have also closed part of the school due to lack of staff in some Units. Again – we must emphasise that EVERY EFFORT will be made to stay open. The fact that many of Ysgol y Llys staff live in rural areas must be taken into account, as the effects of the weather can vary greatly from area to area. This is one of the few instances where the running of the school is affected due to the weather.

If a decision is made to close the school – we will contact the parents as soon as possible. The Head teacher will e-mail parents and a message will be posted on the school's website [-www.ysgolyllys.co.uk](http://www.ysgolyllys.co.uk). It will also be posted on the school official Facebook account. Parents can also contact the school on 01745 853019 first thing in the morning for more information. Updates will also be made on our official Twitter account @YYllys. We will also inform Denbighshire CC who will in turn update their website which lists school closures.
